- Bachelor's degree in Child/Human Development or closely-related field
- Minimum 3.0 GPA in the last 60.0 semester (90.0 quarter) units completed

 - Upper division research methods (CHAD 133, CHAD 123, CHAD 128, or equivalent) AND
 - Upper division child/human development survey course (CHAD 137, CHAD 138, or equivalent)
- Experience in programs serving children from infancy through primary grades
- Strong writing communication skills

Note: Applicants with preparation and experiences different from those listed above may be admitted under a conditional status.
