The MA in Gender Equity in Education program offers the opportunity for students to develop an understanding of the many political and social issues affecting gender issues in schools, the workforce and the impact on society. The program prepares graduates to educate others about social gender constructs and gender-fair practices in schools, government, non-profit agencies, the public sector, and in universities. Graduates from this program will have the skills to address issues of equity, diversity, anti-racism, and intersectionality in schooling and the workplace. Courses are offered in the evening for full-time working adults. No GRE required or teaching credential required.
