Complete the FAFSA / CA Dream Application

The <u>FAFSA</u> / <u>CA DREAM</u> applications provide access to over \$30,000 dollars in grants, scholarships, and other financial aid up to Cost of Attendance -- Applications open October 1.

Complete by March 2 to qualify for the maximum benefit!

Meet with College of Education Student Success Center

Apply for Scholarships

Sacramento State and the College of Education offer hundreds of scholarships. That could mean \$1,000s of dollars in free money for school that you do not need to repay! Applications open Oct 2 and close March 20



Prepare Credential Program Application

Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and SpecialEd deadline is February 1



Meet with the Financial Aid Team

Review your personalized financial aid options, ask questions, and provide any additional documentation before the May 1 deadline



Apply for a Teacher Residency Program
