kindergarten to age 22

**Extensive Support  
Needs (ESN):** *online*,  
teach students with  
extensive support  
needs, kindergarten to  
age 22

**Deaf & Hard of  
Hearing (DHH):** *online*, teach  
students who are deaf  
or hard of hearing,  
birth to age 22

**Master of Arts in Teaching-Special Education (MAT-SPED)** *online*, option to complete in one more year  
after ECSE, ESN, MMSN, and DHH pathways, summer start + fall & spring
