To qualify for a preliminary credential, the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) requires that you provide evidence of completion of CPR training that includes <u>infant, child and adult skills</u>. Verification of current CPR training must be submitted to the Teaching Credentials Department before you finish the credential program.
