

Applying to a MAT / MASET Program

Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to a Master of Arts in Teaching / Master of Arts in Special Education Teaching, applicants must meet the minimum qualifications:

- 1. Completion of a preliminary teaching credential in the corresponding concentration within the last 7 years.
- 2. Meet the Grade Requirement for the MAT / MASET Degree
- 3. Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.0 in last 60 semester or 90 quarter units as evidenced from official transcripts from every college/university attended.
- 4. To successfully complete this program, students must actively serve as the permit teacher or designated teacher of record in a classroom setting during the research phase. This requirement ensures the practical application and direct implementation of learned concepts in a real-world educational environment.

Admission Procedures

A. TEACHING CREDENTIAL:

SUBMISSION: Upload verification as described above

B. ESSAY:

Write a personal statement of 500-750 words to explain your personal teaching philosophy and goals for your continued professional development. Discuss the aspect of your teaching that you wish to improve and how this focus might benefit your students and school community. Include in-text citations as evidence to support your ideas. In-text citations must follow the formatting guidelines in the 7th Edition of the APA Publication Manual.

SUBMISSION: Upload essay as described above.

C. UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS:

One set of unofficial transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, other than Sacramento State.

SUBMISSION: Submit **one set** of ALL unofficial transcripts.

You will be asked to submit email contact information for two references. If possible, one reference should be from a person who has observed you working with the age group you intend to teach.
