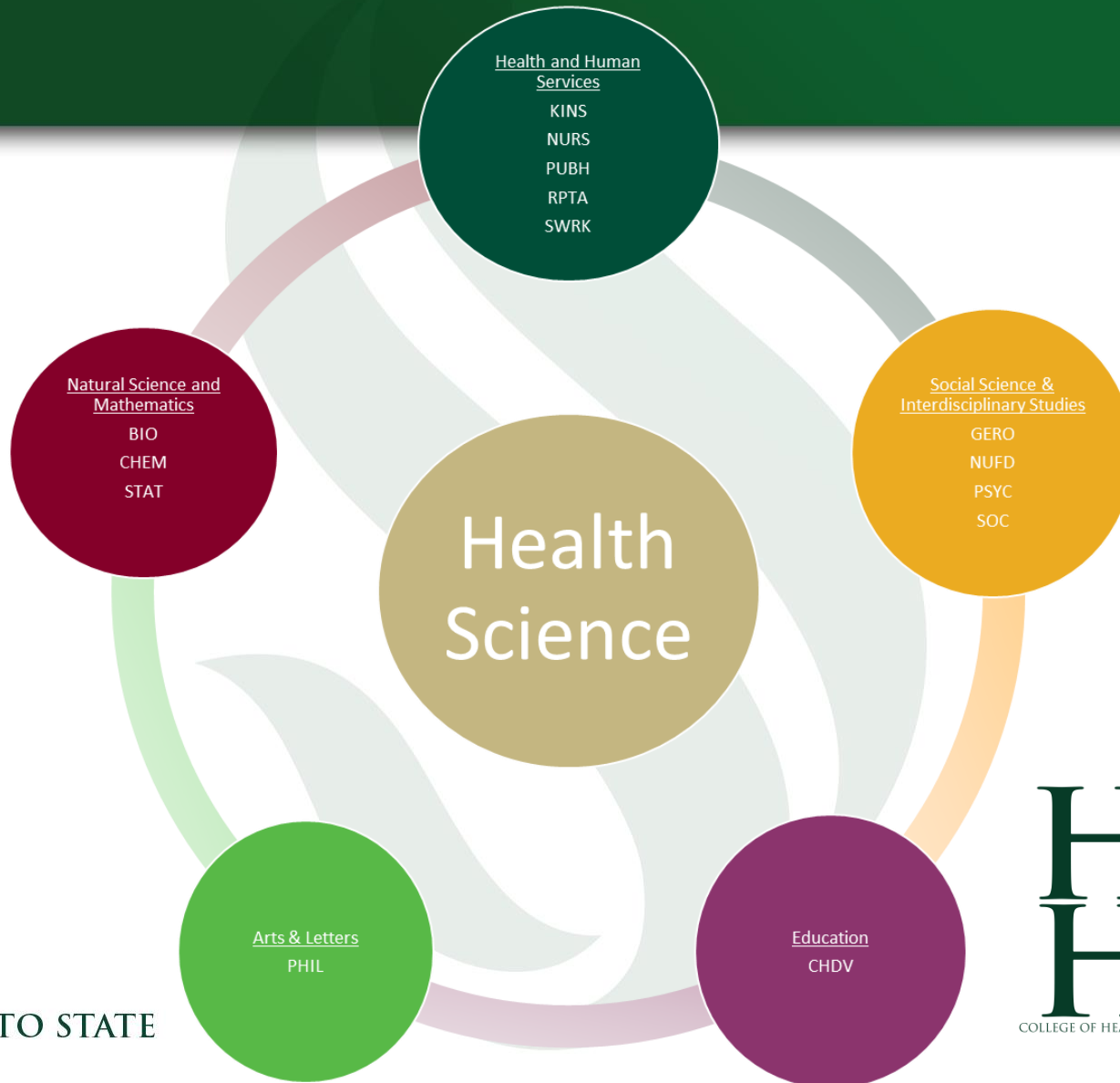

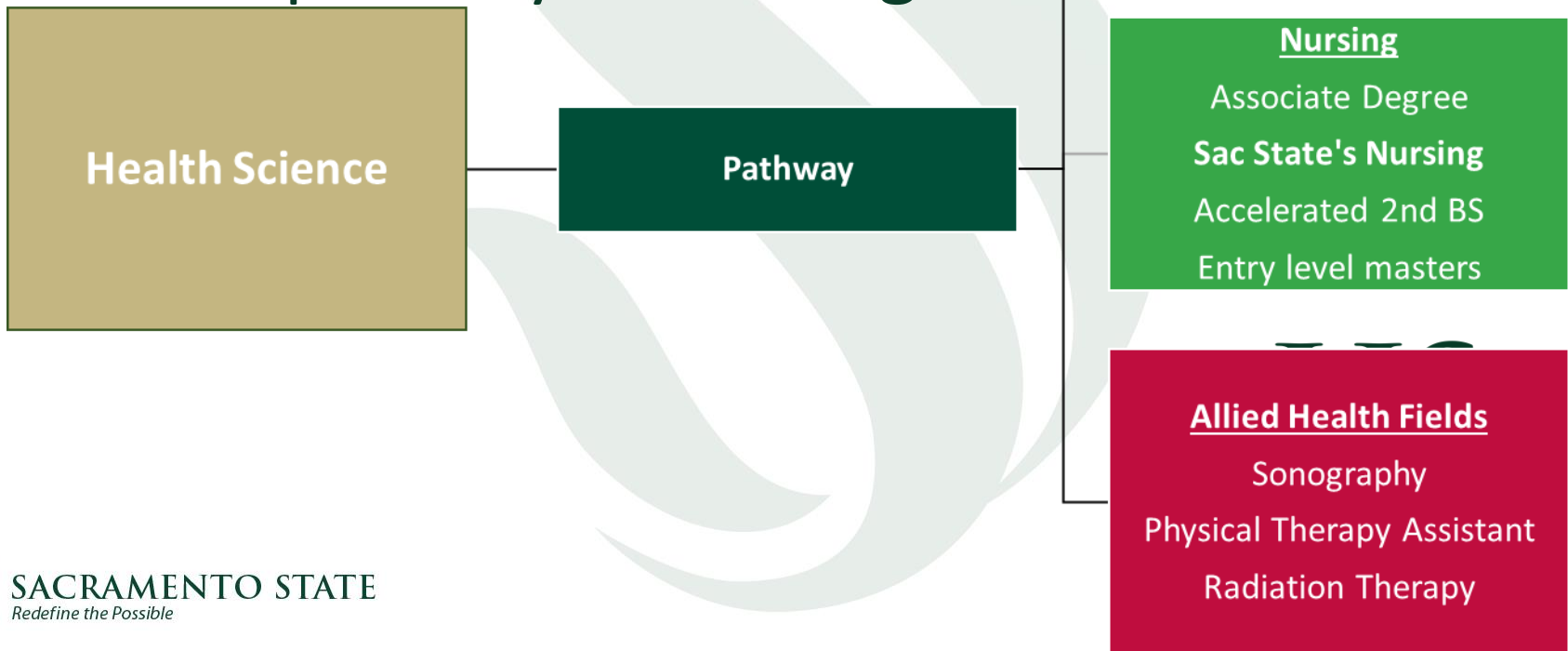

Nursing Requirements

Prerequisites

- Oral Com. (G.E. Area A1 course)
- Written Com. (G.E. Area A2 course)
- Critical Thinking (G.E. Area A3 course)
- Statistics (G.E. Area B4 statistics course)

Sciences:

- General Chemistry **OR** inorganic **OR** organic (**CHEM 6A**)
- Anatomy **or** A & P I (**BIO 25**)
- Physiology **or** A & P II (**BIO 26**)
- Microbiology (**BIO 39**)

Corequisites

- Life Span – Human Development (**CHDV 30**)
- Introductory Psychology (**PSYC 2**)
- Nutrition (**NUFD 10**)
- Social-Cultural Course (**SOC 1, ANTH 2, 101, 186, ETHN 11, 100, or HRS 161 or equivalent**)

Nursing Requirements

- Admit up to 80 students both Fall and Spring
- Selection is based on the rank ordering of admission points earned:
 - 40 - “Adjusted” Nursing GPA
 - 30 - TEAS test
 - 18 - Optional Criteria points
 - 88 points maximum
 - 60 points min to apply
- Last person admitted for Spring 2019 had 67 points.
- Average Nursing GPA = 3.995
- Average Teas Score = 91.75%
