

Announcement of Public Meeting/ Opportunity for Public Comment

The doctoral Au.D. program in audiology (residential) at California State University, Sacramento is a Candidate for Accreditation by the Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (CAA) of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association, 2200 Research Boulevard, #310, Rockville, MD 20850, (800) 498-2071 or (301) 296-5700. Candidacy is a “preaccreditation” status with the CAA, awarded to developing or emerging programs for a maximum period of 5 years.

The Au.D. program is undergoing a site visit for Initial Accreditation. Individuals who wish to provide input about a program seeking initial accreditation may do so in two ways:

1. By submitting written comments prior to the accreditation site visit in accordance with the procedures specified in the Policy on Public Comment; all comments about education programs are due in the Accreditation Office no later than fifteen (15) days before the first day of the scheduled site visit, **or**
2. Attending and providing comments at a public meeting during the program’s scheduled site visit:

All comments must:

- Relate to a program’s compliance with the current Standards for Accreditation
- Identify the specific program seeking candidacy, initial accreditation, or continued accreditation with the CAA
- All written testimony—including comments faxed or submitted as email attachments—must include the commenter’s name, address, telephone contact information, and the commenter’s relationship to the program in order for Accreditation staff to verify the source of the testimony. All comments must be signed.
