Engaging in interprofessional practice models reduce errors, improve satisfaction, and make healthcare more cost effective. This workshop will serve to bring together student professionals from speech language pathology, pharmacy, nursing, physical therapy, and social work to problem solve common clinical case scenarios best addressed by an interprofessional team.



Dr. Ofstad serves as the Assistant Dean for Education at California Health Sciences University, focused on faculty development and mentorship in team-based learning in California's Central Valley. His primary research focus is in teaching and learning including team-based learning, team building, simulation, and interprofessional education.
