

How are you going to deliver services???

- Face to Face
- Hybrid
- Evaluation in person but tele-practice therapy
- Zoom/Webex
- Packets and family training/teamwork

If you are in person or hybrid:

- <u>Student Acknowledgement Form</u> created by risk management. Remember, face to face internships are voluntary. Students are provided other options if they don't want face to face, including virtual experiences or program extension (last resort)
- <u>Student Training Learner Web Certificate</u> filed before they go out to internship csusac.learnerhall.com
- <u>Site Verification Form</u> that the internship coordinator has reviewed with the site and initialed and filed.
- · All parties educated on the reporting of student or exposure

Benefits of Tele-practice?

- The use of videoconferencing for remote supervision (i.e., e-supervision, tele-supervision) in speech-language pathology was first described by Dudding and Justice (2004) as being an effective means of providing supervision.
- The benefits include the <u>students</u> increased feelings of <u>autonomy</u>, <u>convenience and flexibility</u> in scheduling, and adaptability to the needs of the student (Dudding & Justice, 2004).







Teach

- Discous and define strategies
- Provide relativing behind strategies.
- Overcoss worve to use the strategy and rate play.
- Y Assert key questions



Model

- Speech pathwing lit med all language strategies with the drift.
- Highlight the strategy used to the caregiver
- Explain specific strategies used during interactions



Coach

- Purelit practices the language strategies with the child.
- Speech pathologist or aches the caregiver during interactions
- Speech pathwingsit gives positive and constructive feedback to the correliver



Review

- Speech pathologist and caregiver discuss the session.
- Discuss how the caregiver's strategies linked to the child's following behaviors
- Make a plant for use of strategies at home.
