## Immunizations, Testing & Vaccines

### All Students

Per the campus Immunizations, Testing & Vaccines webpage (<https://www.csus.edu/student-life/health-counseling/health/immunizations-and-vaccines.html>)

“California State University (CSU) requires all students to be current on a number of immunizations and to complete a risk assessment for tuberculosis (CSU Executive Order 803).

This executive order and its requirements apply to undergraduate and graduate students, students matriculated in self-support degree programs and K-12 students participating in concurrent enrollment courses entering the California State University.”

CSAD students enrolled are **required** to provide documentation of passing a one-step Tuberculosis (TB) test **annually**.

All Students are required to have the following immunizations:

- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal ACWY (16-23 years)
- Hepatitis B (18 and younger, CA Health & Safety Code, Sec. 120390.5) Additional Recommended immunizations
- COVID
- Hepatitis A
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza (Flu)
- Meningococcal B (16-23 years)
- Pneumococcal

## Undergraduate students in a clinical practicum course

It is assumed that undergraduate students enrolled in a clinical practicum course (example: CSAD 146) have the campus required vaccinations:

- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal ACWY (16-23 years)
- Hepatitis B (18 and younger, CA Health & Safety Code, Sec. 120390.5)
- Tuberculosis (TB) Screening Requirements: **TB Screening:** Documentation of a one-time two-step TB skin test (if no prior documentation) or a TB blood test (IGRA), followed by **annual TB screening** in accordance with the clinical site's requirements.

**Chest X-ray:** Required only when indicated (e.g., following a positive TB test). If required, a chest X-ray is considered valid for **up to 5 years**, provided the individual remains symptom-free, unless the clinical site requires more frequent documentation.

It is recommended that students also have the following immunizations:

- Hepatitis A
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza (Flu)
- Meningococcal B (16-23 years)

## CSAD MS Students

### All CSAD MS Students

It is assumed that Communication Sciences and Disorders Master of Science program students have the campus required vaccinations:

- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal ACWY (16-23 years)
- Hepatitis B (18 and younger, CA Health & Safety Code, Sec. 120390.5)
- Tuberculosis (TB) Screening Requirements: **TB Screening:** Documentation of a one-time two-step TB skin test (if no prior documentation) or a TB blood test (IGRA), followed by **annual TB screening** in accordance with the clinical site's requirements.  
**Chest X-ray:** Required only when indicated (e.g., following a positive TB test). If required, a chest X-ray is considered valid for **up to 5 years**, provided the individual remains symptom-free, unless the clinical site requires more frequent documentation.

### On-Campus Clinics

CSAD MS students enrolled in an on-campus clinical practicum course (examples: CSAD 229A, 229B, 229C, 243A, 243B, 243C, 245) are **required** to provide documentation of passing a one-step Tuberculosis (TB) test **annually**.

It is recommended that students also have the following immunizations:

- COVID
- Hepatitis A
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza (Flu)
- Meningococcal B (16-23 years)
- Pneumococcal
- Poliovirus
- Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)

### Off-Campus Clinics/Internships/Externships

In addition, CSAD MS students enrolled in an off-campus clinic, internship, or externship (examples: CSAD 295I, 295M, 295P) are required to provide documentation of passing a one-step Tuberculosis (TB) test **annually**.

**Students will also be required to comply with the specific requirements of the off-campus site.**

It is recommended that students also have the following immunizations:

- COVID
- Hepatitis A
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza (Flu)
- Meningococcal B (16-23 years)
- Pneumococcal
- Poliovirus
- Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)

## Au.D Students

### All Au. D. Students

#### Immunizations

- COVID-19 Vaccine (Dose 1 & Dose 2)
- Hepatitis B: Dose 1, 2 & 3
- Influenza (flu) current season
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) Dose 1, 2 & Titer
- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)

**Tuberculosis : (TB) Screening Requirements:** TB Screening: Documentation of a one-time two-step TB skin test (if no prior documentation) or a TB blood test (IGRA), followed by annual TB screening in accordance with the clinical site's requirements.

**Chest X-ray:** Required only when indicated (e.g., following a positive TB test). If required, a chest X-ray is considered valid for up to 5 years, provided the individual remains symptom-free, unless the clinical site requires more frequent documentation.

#### **On-Campus/Off-campus Clinics**

CSAD Au.D students enrolled in an on-campus clinical practicum course (examples: CSAD 610, 620C, 630C, 640C, 650C, 660C, 670C, 680C) are **required** to provide documentation of passing all relevant immunizations including one-step Tuberculosis (TB) test **annually**.

It is recommended that students also have the following immunizations:

- COVID
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza (Flu)
- Meningococcal B (16-23 years)
- Pneumococcal
- Poliovirus
- Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)

#### **Additional Checks:**

- A drug screening may also be required for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> year Au. D. students depending on clinical placement sites.
