- \* To be eligible to submit your Advancement to Candidacy (ATC) form, you have to:
  - Meet the GWAR writing requirement (done with a B or higher grade in CrJ 200);
  - Obtain a B or higher grade in all courses completed during the first year (12 units); and
  - Identify your Thesis/Project Chair and provide name on ATC form (his or her signature on the form is required).

All completed ATC forms (including all signatures) are due to the Office of Graduate Studies (OGS) by October 1<sup>st</sup> for processing (to enroll in a Spring culminating experience course).

*Note:* Students <u>must</u> have an approved ATC form on file with OGS <u>prior</u> to enrolling in a culminating experience course (e.g., CrJ 501).
