Admission Requirements

- A valid California registered nursing license prior to the beginning of the second semester
- California state resident
- Admission to Sacramento State
- Completed RN to BSN online application
- Official transcript of all institutions attended
- A cumulative GPA of 2.6 based on the last 60 semester units of 90 quarter units of graded transferrable course work
- Applicants who are currently employed as an RN will have priority for admission
- Supplemental writing or oral communication course may be required
- Program admission is contingent upon meeting requirements outlined and passing a drug screening and background check.

Prerequisites

The following classes must have been completed with a grade of "C" or better.

In Progress Policy: Classes may be in progress prior to admission. Unofficial transcripts may be submitted for in-progress classes but must be replaced with official transcripts.

REQUIRED Preadmission courses:

- Anatomy or Anatomy and Physiology I (with a lab)
- Physiology or Anatomy and Physiology II (with a lab)
- Microbiology (with a lab)
- Chemistry (integrated or organic chemistry is not required)
- Written Communication
- Oral Communication
- Statistics
- Critical Thinking
