ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1

You are in a course of study in the areas of safety, workplace safety, or management that may lead you, after graduation, to a professional position in which the fully accredited CSHM credential is available.

2

You are a Junior or later in school with 30 credit hours of undergraduate education in the courses cited above -or- 12 credit hours of associated graduate school education -or- have achieved a minimum of 1,500 hours of associated work experience in the safety, workplace safety, or management fields and have returned to school for additional education at an IHMM-approved undergraduate or graduate school.

ST/ASHM EXAMINATION INFORMATION

The ST/ASHM examination is comprised of **75 multiple-choice questions**. The questions on the exam are drawn from the ST/ASHM blueprint. Careful preparation and study are strongly encouraged.

You are not eligible to take the exam until properly registered and have paid your IHMM registration fee.

Online testing is the standard method of administration for the ST/ASHM examination. The allotted time to complete the ST/ASHM examination is ninety minutes [90].

HOW TO COMPLETE THE ONLINE APPLICATION

1. You can apply for the ST/ASHM certification by using the online certification system.
2. Record your experience or education on the application.
3. Pay the \$15 application and exam fee.
4. Submit your application.
