- 3. Describe the evidence-based research you will complete to guide the project.
- 4. Discuss what you will turn in for grading. For example, if your final project involves conducting a special event, you will need to create a detailed paper outlining every aspect of how you created the event, from conceptualizing the idea to copies of forms you used. All reports must include a personal evaluation of the project. What did you learn? What went well? What would you do differently if you completed this project again?
