Summer Research Grants \$2000-\$4000

The Chemistry Department is planning to offer 2-4 summer research grants for undergraduates.

In order to apply, you must be:

- A Chemistry or Biochemistry major
- Enrolled in or have completed at least one of these Chemistry labs: Chem 25, 31, 110L, 125, 141, 162 **OR** have conducted research with a Chemistry faculty member for at least one semester.
- Sponsored by a Chemistry faculty member (lab instructor or research mentor) with whom you will be doing the research.

Two forms of support are available to students:

- **Project Grants** will be available for up to \$500 for supplies, equipment, services and travel directly related to activities for approved research projects.
- **Stipends.** Students working on approved research projects will be paid at a rate of \$16.00/hour during the summer. A maximum of **\$4,000** will be available for each student.

Total requested budget (project grant + stipend) should be in the range of \$2000 - \$4000. While smaller requests will be considered, larger requests will not be allowed.
