## Lisa Hammersley

- The NSM Joint Council is being revived by the NSM ASI Director after not being very active over the past few years. There was a showcase event outside of Sequoia with club info and prizes which had to end early because there was such a high turnout. On Thursday there was a planning for success panel event with virtual speakers in TSC 1001 and pizza was provided. Ron Coleman spoke at the event as well as a student alumnus, and speaker from the Student Health Center. NSM JC will continue to develop efforts in the spring to bring students together and help build a sense of community on campus.
- The NSM holiday party is Thursday at 12-1:30pm on the TSC $2^{\text {nd }}$ floor patio with lunch for everyone who would like to attend.
- Frosh/Soph. enrollment is extremely low with many classes sitting empty. This may be due to Hornet Launch which only takes place in the fall so faculty should advise students accordingly. NSM Advising has placed holds on $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ year students so if students need the holds removed send them to the NSM Advising Office.


## Shannon Datwyler

- The NSM-fest event planning is moving forward with the organizing group meeting to come up with ideas for the event and how to re-engage students with the college and departments. The event is planned to take place the $2^{\text {nd }}$ week of the semester with some events that can be completed at any time during the week and some more coordinated events involving student clubs and departments on Wednesday and Thursday. More information to come out soon.
- Last semester Shannon and Gabrielle in the NSM Advising Center put on a 6-week workshop for faculty advisors which they would like to continue with trainings in the spring. After sending out a survey of interest, the faculty of the college responded that they would like to have drop in workshops focused on specific topics like graduation applications, catalog, GE requirements, etc. There will be $4-5$ in the spring.

## Thomas Savage

- Before the closure there was discussion about monitors being installed in building lobbies to list directory information. Tom asked if this was still in the works. Associate Dean for Student Success search committee selection

Shannon Datwyler is currently serving as interim and left the meeting and did not participate in this discussion.
