- All courses except general electives must be completed with a grade of "C-" or better.
- Availability of anthropology courses varies each semester. Consult semester schedules online and with your Anthropology Advisor.
- You can overlap between GE and major coursework approved for fullfilling both areas. Not all anthropology courses serve toward the major. For example: Anth 13, 16, 101, 102, 121 ONLY count for GE requirements.
