## **All Renaissance Classes and Events Are Canceled for the Rest of the Semester!**

In light of rapidly changing concerns regarding the COVID-19 virus, **all Renaissance Society seminars, classes, activities and other events are now canceled through the end of the Spring Semester on May 20.**

This decision is consistent with (1) CSUS policies and procedures; (2) recommendations from the Sacramento County Department of Health Services; and (3) directives from California's Gov. Gavin Newsom.

The cancellation pertains to all RS learning and service activities listed in the RS Spring Catalog, including the following:

- All Friday and Saturday on-campus seminars and events, including the Forum;
- All off-campus seminars, group activities and other events, regardless of location;
- All Speakers Series at residential communities, community centers and libraries;
- All University Volunteer Services, including mentoring of students.

- The Annual Scholarships Awards Luncheon (previously scheduled for May 6.)

Information about this year's election for RS officers and members-at-large will be provided prior to the election. There will also be an announcement about recipients of this year's RS Scholarship awards.

As we emphasized in our prior message, **the health and safety of all RS members is the number one priority of the Board of Directors.** We will be monitoring this situation closely and will provide updates as needed. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
