Program Goals

Provide undergraduate students with an introduction to the theory and practice of teaching English to non-native speakers.

Program of Study

The program consists of six courses (18 units) which must be taken at CSUS:

- English 110A (Linguistics and the English Language)
- English 110P (Second Language Learning and Teaching)
- English 110Q (Grammar for ESL Teachers)
- English 125E (Academic Reading and Writing for Second Language Students)
- English 125F (Teaching Oral Skills)
- Elective course to be chosen from English 110 series

Notes

1. English majors are **not** eligible for the Minor in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL), but they may complete the TESOL Certificate - Option A.
2. Courses applied to other degree programs cannot apply to the TESOL minor.
