DR. FRED BALDINI

'82, MA '85 (Kinesiology)
Provost, Samuel Merritt University

The former dean of Health and Human Services at Sacramento State, Dr. Baldini made a substantial impact during his 31 years on campus, including creating new academic programs and establishing Folsom Hall as a hub for the health sciences. After transferring from Porterville College, Fred earned his bachelor's and master's degrees in Kinesiology at Sacramento State, and a doctorate in Exercise Science from Arizona State. After returning to Sacramento State, Fred served as a Kinesiology professor and three-term department chair before becoming associate dean for the College of Health and Human Services and then dean in 2010. During his tenure, Fred led efforts to develop new programs like the Physical Therapy and Audiology doctorates, a master of Public Health, and a Health Service bachelor's degree. After serving as dean for nine years, Fred left Sacramento State in 2019 to become provost and vice president for Academic Affairs at Samuel Merritt University.



DR. JOSEFINA DOMINGUEZ

'08 (Biological Sciences)
Vascular Surgeon, Sutter Medical Center, Sacramento

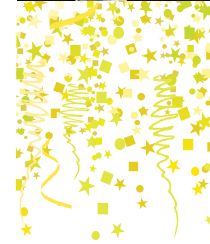
A first-generation college student and child of a single mother, Dr. Dominguez set her sights high despite having little guidance for navigating the path to and through college. As one of the few women in her field, she now is a vascular surgeon at Sutter Medical Center in Sacramento, treating patients with dangerous and deadly diseases of the blood vessels. She credits Sacramento State's Summer Bridge Academy and other on-campus programs for helping her navigate college life to earn her bachelor's degree in Biological Science. Josefina received her medical degree from the University of Washington in Seattle, then completed her residency at the University of Southern California in the highly competitive and male-dominated field of vascular surgery. Josefina is a role model to all students and encourages them to never let their circumstances hold them back from doing what they love.



DR. ED MANANSALA

'92 (Business/HR), MSW '98, Cred. '01, '04
County Superintendent of Schools,
El Dorado County Office of Education

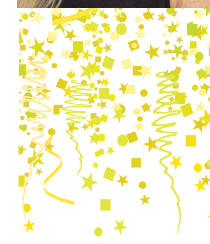
Dr. Manansala's passion for education and serving his community is helping change lives. Ed graduated from Sacramento State with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration and then moved to Oak Park where he mentored young people and coached youth basketball. After witnessing the effects of gang activity and drugs on his community, Ed returned to Sacramento State to earn his master's degree in Social Work. His experience motivated him to bring long-term, systemic changes to Oak Park and neighborhoods like it. He felt he could best make change through education and pursued three credentials at Sacramento State before earning his doctorate in Educational Leadership at UC Davis. He has served as El Dorado County's superintendent of schools since 2016. In 2019, Ed served as president of the California County Superintendents' Educational Services Association and vice-chair of the State Board of Education's California Practitioners Advisory Group. He also served on Gov. Newsom's Charter School Task Force.



COL. PATRICIA WEBB

MA '89 (International Affairs)
Consultant; Retired Colonel, U.S. Air Force

When a young Patricia Webb said she wanted to be an astronaut, her mother suggested being a flight attendant. Patricia, however, stuck to her dream of taking to the skies, earning her pilot's license at age 21, and embarking on a groundbreaking career. With few opportunities available to female pilots, she traveled the world as an Air Force navigator, taking on tactical missions during the Gulf War and humanitarian relief missions in Somalia. She earned an undergraduate degree in liberal arts from Kalamazoo College. During a stint as a flight instructor at Mather Air Force Base, Patricia earned her master's degree from Sacramento State in International Affairs. Her service in the Air Force service helped pave the way for female pilots and women in the military. Since retiring as a colonel in 2011 after 33 years in the military, she has worked in counterterrorism and advising presidential Cabinet members and members of Congress while also teaching at the National Intelligence University.



Distinguished Service Award



KRISTIN WRIGHT

'07 (Sociology), Cred. '09, MA '12 (Special Education)
Executive Director, Equity, Prevention & Intervention,
Sacramento County Office of Education

Kristin's drive to understand people and the human condition led her to a bachelor's degree in Sociology at Sacramento State. After her daughter Shelby was born with significant disabilities, she decided to pursue her teaching credential and master's degree in Special Education. Her decision to change course unlocked a passion for improving educational equity. Kristin's personal experiences allowed her to learn first-hand how systems intended to help those with disabilities were working or not working for students and families, which she has brought to her work at all levels. Today, she serves as the Sacramento County Office of Education's director of Equity, Prevention, and Intervention, directly impacting nearly 800,000 students with disabilities in California. Kristin credits faculty and the culture of inclusion embedded into Sacramento State's Special Education Credential Program for providing her with the guidance and support needed to launch her career in education.

Rising Star Award



JAMIL JAN KOCHAI

'14 (English)
Author

Born in a refugee camp in Pakistan, Jamil Jan Kochai immigrated to the United States as an infant. At age 12, he traveled back to Afghanistan, his family's homeland, which inspired his highly acclaimed debut novel, *99 Nights in Logar*. Jamil's novel was a finalist for the Pen/Hemingway Award and has appeared in multiple publications, including *The New Yorker*, *The New York Times*, and the *Los Angeles Times*. After graduating from Sacramento State with a bachelor's degree in English, he earned a master's degree in Creative Writing from UC Davis and was the Truman Capote Distinguished Fellow at the Iowa University Writer's Workshop. Currently, Jamil is in his second year of the Wallace Stegner Fellowship at Stanford University and is working on his second novel. He credits Sacramento State faculty with encouraging him to pursue his interest in writing and helping launch his career.
