

SUSTAINABILITY STEERING COMMITTEE



Sacramento State has established the University Sustainability Committee to strengthen its sustainability efforts in alignment with the goals of the CSU Sustainability Policy, California Assembly Bill 32 and the University's carbon neutrality goal by the year 2040.

The Committee is charged with responsibility for assessing current sustainability practices for incorporation of best technology; recommending new methods/techniques for incorporating sustainability into operational activities and facilities design; partnering with the community we serve; and identifying and tracking critical performance indicators to keep sustainability practices and strategies on course.

The Committee concentration includes the following Areas of Focus for sustainable practices: Academics; Dining Services; Energy; Environmental Health & Safety; Landscape; Planning, New Construction, Renewal; Procurement; Recycle/Waste Management; Transportation; Water Conservation.

Committee membership is reflective of the Areas of Focus and includes representatives from the following organizations:
