## IF YOU ARE APPROACHED BY IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT

CALM »	Remember to remain calm if the interaction causes concern. Safety is our top priority. Ask for their name, identification number, or agency affiliation.
REPORT >>	If the agent does not respond and proceeds assertively with their actions, or enters non-public spaces without permission, <b>do not interfere or obstruct them</b> .

INFORM >> "I am not authorized to speak with you, answer your questions, or provide access to any people."
