

2022 Student Research and Creative Activity Fall Poster Forum

Call for Applications

The Student Research Center invites applications for the 2022 Student Research and Creative Activity Fall Poster Forum. The purpose of the Fall Poster Forum is to give undergraduates, graduates, and recent alumni the opportunity to present their research and creative projects to the campus community in poster format. Submitted posters must be **sponsored by a faculty mentor** overseeing the work of submission. Each presentation is allowed an unlimited number of co-authors and presenters. This event is not a competition and the posters presented at this event will not be judged.

Date and Time: The poster event will be held **in person** on **Thursday, October 27th** in the Redwood Room of the University Union. Each poster will be presented in one of three sessions, running at the following times:

Session 1: 9 - 10:30 am

Session 2: 11 - 12:30 pm

Session 3: 1 - 2:30 pm.

Eligibility: Currently registered students and alumni who received their degrees in Spring 2022 are eligible to participate in the Fall Forum. Additionally, while all presenters must be enrolled students at Sacramento State, co-authors need not be a student and may include faculty or others.

Registration: While a poster may have multiple authors, only the Main or First Author should do the following, i.e., one email per poster. The First Author should compose an email with the following subject line:

Subject: Fall Poster Forum registration

The email body must include the following information:

Name of first author: Last name(s), First name(s) e.g., Smith, Teri

Email of first author: e.g., tsmith@csus.edu

Department of presenter: e.g., Biological Sciences

Name of Faculty Advisor: e.g., Coleman, Ronald

Email of faculty advisor: e.g., rcoleman@csus.edu

Title of Poster: e.g., "The Life of Brian"

Preferred session: 9-10:30, 11-12:30 or 1-2:30

Names of additional co-authors if any: e.g., "Carr, Emily", "Jackson, AY"

Please make sure you obtain prior approval from your faculty mentor before submitting the application.
