Prerequisites: Two years of High School Spanish or Spanish 1A at the University.

Course Description and Objectives: The goal of this course is to help students to develop competency in Spanish at a high intermediate to advanced level. Students will acquire the ability to understand main ideas in description and narration of new items, personal correspondence, technical material written for general readers, and simple short stories. Students will demonstrate general comprehension of a text and will be able to answer content questions in English and in Spanish. The grammar will be taught as an extension of the usage found in the reading selections.

Emphasis will be placed on various reading techniques: Skimming or guessing content from the context, deciphering parts of the message, and later (as the student's vocabulary improves) reading the entire message without being defeated by unknown words. By the end of the course, students will handle any modern Spanish material with the aid of a dictionary. It is also intended that students develop an understanding of basic grammatical concepts and an appreciation of the diverse Hispanic culture.

To attain these goals, the focus of the course will be in reading as much as possible in Spanish and each student is expected to utilize language skills to the maximum.
