- **STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARD:** Sacramento State's OneCard is the University's digital-image identification card for all students. The OneCard provides access to campus services and is available at the OneCard Center, Lassen Hall.

- **SACLINK ACCOUNTS:** SaLink is the University's electronic identification and authentication system. The services include e-mail, dial-in Internet access, personal web pages, file storage, and Sac State's public directory. SaLink authentication provides access to campus network resources such as My Sac State, WebCt, Library resources, and University computing labs.
