Examination is taken upon completion of ADN program at Sierra College.

Recommend completing both at Sierra College prior to transfer to CSUS. Units count toward BSN in CSUS GE Area D3.

CSUS Graduation requirements also include 1) **one Ethnic Studies course** (can be met with ANTH 101 during the first semester of the BSN program) 2) passing the **Writing Placement for Juniors (WPJ) Exam (should be taken the first semester of the BSN program.)**
