Spring 2019

- 247 applicants (76 enrolled, 17 declined, 11 ineligible, 38 qualified alternates, 115 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data.)
- Point cut off – **67** (*maximum 88 points possible*)
- Statistics for 76 enrolled students:
 - Average “Non-Adjusted” Nursing GPA* – 3.919 (range 3.618 – 4.00)
 - Average “Adjusted” Nursing GPA – 3.995 (range 3.781 – 4.00)
 - Average TEAS test score – 91.75% (range 82.70% – 98.7%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 10.4
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Fall 2018

- 500 applicants (77 enrolled, 15 declined, 7 ineligible, 31 qualified alternates, 294 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data, additional 76 with admission point totals below 60-point minimum requirement)
- Point cut off – **79** (*maximum 100 points possible*)
- Statistics for 77 enrolled students:
 - Average “Non-Adjusted” Nursing GPA* – 3.928 (range 3.700 – 4.0)
 - Average “Adjusted” Nursing GPA – 3.998 (range 3.875 – 4.000)
 - Average TEAS test score – 91.4% (range 84.0% – 98.7%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 11.5
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Spring 2018

- 375 applicants (77 enrolled, 7 declined, 3 ineligible, 47 qualified alternates, 241 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data)
- Point cut off – **84** (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 77 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.990 (range 3.833 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 92.5% (range 88.0% – 98.7%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 4.9
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Fall 2017

- 469 applicants (77 enrolled, 35 declined, 18 ineligible, 30 qualified alternates, 309 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data)
- Point cut off – **77** (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 77 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.962 (range 3.717 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 90.9% (range 85.3% – 97.3%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 5
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Spring 2017

- 289 applicants (79 enrolled, 9 declined, 10 ineligible, 30 qualified alternates, 161 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data)
- Point cut off – **76** (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 79 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.962 (range 3.736 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 90.0% (range 84.0% – 96.7%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 6
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Fall 2016

- 441 applicants (77 enrolled, 28 declined, 13 ineligible, 42 qualified alternates, 281 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data)
- Point cut off – **78** (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 77 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.970 (range 3.794 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 89.9% (range 82.7% – 98.0%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 5
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Spring 2016

- 293 applicants (80 enrolled, 10 declined, 14 ineligible, 18 qualified alternates, 171 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data)
- Point cut off – **75** (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 80 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.957 (range 3.736 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 89.7% (range 84.0% – 98.0%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 6
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Fall 2015

- 500 applicants (78 enrolled, 21 declined, 56 ineligible, 65 qualified alternates, 280 with admission point totals below the alternate range based on student-reported data)
- Point cut off – **76** (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 78 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.969 (range 3.789 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 89.7% (range 84.0% – 97.3%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 5
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Spring 2015

- 287 applicants (78 enrolled, 4 declined, 56 ineligible, 149 qualified alternates)
- Point cut off – **73** (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 78 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.952 (range 3.647 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 89.5% (range 83.3% – 96.0%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 5
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*

Fall 2014

- 462 applicants (80 enrolled, 34 declined, 107 ineligible, 241 qualified alternates)
- Point cut off – 71 (*maximum 112 points possible*)
- Statistics for 80 enrolled students:
 - Average GPA* – 3.954 (range 3.756 – 4.0)
 - Average TEAS test score – 89.3% (range 82.0% – 100%)
 - Average points earned for Optional Criteria – 4.4
 - *GPA of 8 prerequisite and 4 corequisite courses.*
