**Bachelor of Science in Nursing
Supplemental Nursing Application –
Optional Criteria**

The following Optional Criteria are **not** required for admission to the clinical nursing program—they are an opportunity to raise your total admission points.

- There are six categories:
 1. Health Related Work Experience (1-3 points)
 2. Bilingual Language Proficiency (3 points)
 3. First Generation College Student (4 points)
 4. Environmental Background (4 points)
 5. No Courses Omitted from Adjusted Nursing GPA (2 points)
 6. No Repeated Courses Included in Prerequisite/Corequisite Course GPA (2 points)

NOTE: Economic Background, Optional Criteria points are no longer offered. The Economic Background criteria was tied to a U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Scholarships for Disadvantaged Students (SDS) Grant which is no longer funded.

- Points are awarded based on the review of documentation submitted with your supplemental nursing application—**points are not guaranteed!**
- You will have an opportunity to select the categories you would like to be considered for when you submit your online supplemental nursing application.
- Due to impaction, deadlines are strictly enforced. **Candidates are not permitted to apply for Optional Criteria after the application deadline—documentation received after the document deadlines outlined below will not be considered.**
- Reapplying? If you submitted a supplemental nursing application Spring 2018 or later your documents are still on file! **If you applied before Spring 2018—since we have moved to online platform, you will need to resubmit all optional criteria documentation per instructions below.**

1. Health Related Work Experience (1-3 Points)

- Candidates may receive a maximum of 3 points for documentation of paid or volunteer work in an acute, long-term, clinical, or community setting involving direct human-client/patient interaction.
- Minimum 50 hours
- 50 to 74 hours – 1 point
- 75 to 99 hours – 2 points
- 100 or more hours – 3 points maximum
- Hours may be combined from multiple locations.
- Agency documentation must include your **name**, brief **description of duties**, **total hours completed**, and agency representative **signature**.
- Do **not** submit any documentation to the School of Nursing.

2. Bilingual Language Proficiency (3 Points)

- Points are awarded for oral proficiency in one of the approved languages below (including American Sign Language).
- Oral proficiency examination or foreign transcript required.
- **Oral proficiency examination must be completed by March 1* for Fall, October 1 for Spring*.**
- Questions regarding scheduling an assessment? See instructions included in Nursing Proficiency Testing form below.
- **Approved Languages:** Spanish, Chinese, Southeast Asian languages, Russian and other Slavic languages, Farsi, Arabic, Tagalog, Hindi and Punjabi and other Indic languages.
- These languages were chosen based on the needs of our regional, clinical agencies and census data.
- We regret points are not awarded for French, German, or other languages where a “need” has not been identified.
- American Sign Language – Completion of a 4th-semester, college-level ASL course required (*Sac State DEAF 154 or equivalent, may not be in progress*); or 3 years of high school course work.

3. First Generation College Student (4 Points)

- Neither parent/guardian has an associate or higher degree awarded by a U.S. or foreign college at the time of application.

4. Environmental Background (4 Points)

- These points are awarded based on an Executive Order by the CSU Chancellor's office to provide a local student advantage.
- Local student is defined by the university; not the School of nursing.

- These points are awarded to students who attended a local high school or who have earned the majority of their transfer credits locally (local community college).
- If you are requesting these points, please indicate if requesting:
 - a. Based on your high school (must submit high school transcript as evidence) or
 - b. Based on transfer credits.
- Partial points will be awarded for those who completed the majority of their prerequisites at Sac State (No documentation required)

5. No Courses Omitted from Adjusted Nursing GPA (2 Points)

- Candidates may earn 2 points if no courses are omitted from their “Adjusted” Nursing GPA.
- Must have more than 8 grades to calculate in “Adjusted” Nursing GPA to earn 2 points.

6. No Repeated Courses Included in Nursing Prerequisite/Corequisite Course GPA (2 Points)

- Candidates may earn 2 points if the courses included on their supplemental nursing application are all first attempts.
- The seven-year rule does not apply – courses over 7 years old are considered.
