Homecoming- 3-5pm on October 13th. We will be setting up a booth for the pregame festival, with science experiments aimed towards kids. The experiments we will be doing include:

- Slime

- Ferrofluid
- Mentos and Coke (Maybe, depending on the location of our booth)
