- 2. In class on Thursday 9/17, each group will spend roughly 10 minutes describing their article to the class. This presentation should clearly address each of the questions above and involve all group members, but you can divide up the work however the group members choose. Presentations can be somewhat informal, but I do require that the group speak from the front of the classroom.
