<b>Relevance</b>	Poster addressed all guiding questions	Poster addressed some guiding questions, or incompletely addressed all questions.	Poster did not address guiding questions.
<b>Completeness</b>	Good summary of all significant issues. Complete, well-researched.	Missing some important information.	Missing critical information or issues.
<b>Analysis</b>	Presents multiple sides of the issue. Provides evidence in support of arguments	Unbalanced presentation. Lacking some evidence	Presents only one side of the issue. Lacking much evidence
<b>Organization</b>	Well organized, easy to follow with organizing devices such as bullet lists or charts.	Organization is harder to follow, with insufficient organizing devices.	No obvious organizational structure, no coherent use of organizing devices
<b>Images</b>	Poster includes both photos and maps that enhance the meaning and organization of the presentation.
