## **The Art of Intercultural Criticism**

- 1. Remember: Criticism is not compartmentalized.
- 2. Don't be over cautious with one group over another.
- 3. Be aware of culturally sensitive areas.
- 4. Be careful of body height and space.
- 5. Be aware of voice tone, pace, loudness.
- 6. Don't talk too much.
- 7. Criticize in private.
- 8. Criticize as a group if possible.
- 9. State situation as a problem, not a criticism.
- 10. Criticize an action, not a person.
- 11. Provide positive reinforcement.
- 12. Listen carefully.
- 13. Communicate respect.
- 14. Be courteous and formal.
- 15. Use humor (but be careful).
- 16. Inquire after family welfare (but be careful).
