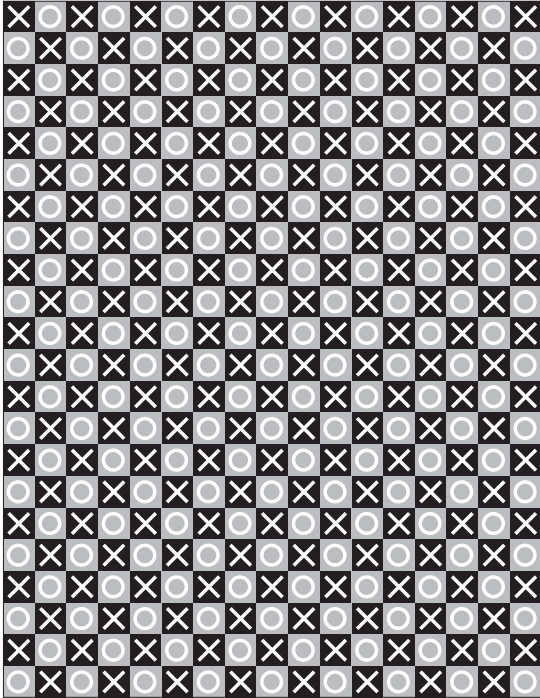


Project #6: Step and repeat Due: Wednesday, April 21

Project description: This project asks you to use InDesign in concert with Illustrator and Photoshop to create a pattern quickly with Step and Repeat. The three resulting pages are saved as a PDF for distribution.

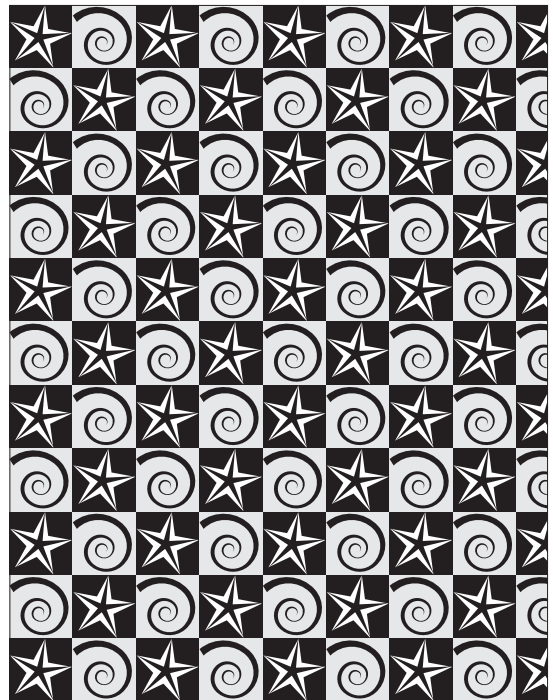
- Instructions:
- a.) Create a three page InDesign file.
 - b.) Save your file with the class number, the assignment number and your initial in the document title.
 - c.) Use InDesign to create the following graphics for page 1:
 - The boxes = .5" square.
 - The gray box = 30% Black.
 - No stroke on the boxes.
 - The "X" and the "O" are drawn with the Line and Oval tools and have a thickness of 4 points.
 - Start from 0"x 0" and fill the page.
 - d.) Use Illustrator to create two graphics for page 2:
 - The two graphics placed inside the boxes should originate from Illustrator. Choose objects or path operations not available in InDesign.
 - Place the items in InDesign. Use InDesign for the following:
 - The boxes = 1" square.
 - The gray box = 30% Black.
 - No stroke on the boxes.
 - Start from 0"x 0" and fill the page.
 - e.) Use Photoshop to create a bitmap TIFF for page 3, then:
 - Place the item in InDesign. Use InDesign for the following:
 - The boxes = 2" square, 45° rotation.
 - 1 point stroke on the boxes.
 - Position the file for effect in the square.
 - Use InDesign to color the item 20% Black (see example).
 - Center on 0"x 0" and fill the page.
 - f.) Save your file with the class number, the assignment number and your initial in the document title. Save a version as a PDF; email to the instructor.

c.) Use InDesign to create page 1...



d.) Use Illustrator to create two graphics for page 2.

e.) Use Photoshop to create a bitmap TIFF for page 3. Place the item in InDesign...
