Why:

I would like to do this as a solo project. I can complete this project using only equipment that I own or have access to outside of the school and will require no use of Sac State's gear or labs. I have had the chance to work with small crews on video projects in FILM 128 and in other classes and I would like to have a chance to produce a project independently before I graduate. I live with my niece and nephew who would be the majority of the on-screen talent and they are no stranger to the camera. They both helped me come up with ideas for what words to use for the letters and will help to pick some of the other details about the locations and props for the production. The other cast member, Jeremy Greene, has worked in front of the camera and microphone on numerous other video and musical projects that I've been involved with and we have a great working chemistry. Also, I hope to produce educational programming for children of all ages after graduation and this will help solidify my foundation in that field.
