Assignment 2 Research Proposal

Instructions:

The proposal should be roughly three pages long. With all the appropriate information included, it should not be shorter than two and a half pages.

Your proposal <u>must</u> contain the following elements:

- 1. Motivation and statement of your research problem/question
 - Explain why the issue at hand is important, citing numbers/fact if possible.
- 2. A brief survey of the literature.
 - Summarize the most relevant scholarly articles (journal articles) very briefly
- 3. The economic theory and economic analysis (with citations when possible) about the problem
- 4. The construction of the data, with descriptions and sources. You need to be as specific as possible.
- 5. Methodology
 - You do not need to be too specific yet. However, you do need to specify your dependent variable and potential independent variables.
 - Also, according to the theory you stated in section 3, formulate the hypothesis that you'll be testing.
- 6. References

Some reminders:

- 1. You will present your proposal in class, so please make sure you do a good job on this.
- 2. You may not be able to make your proposal as specific as you wish. In any case, you should still try to do your best. View the proposal as a game plan or road map to your project. The better plan you have, the easier it is to carry it out.
