Objectives:

Create an artwork that incorporates both digital and non-digital processes and techniques. This could be: a sculptural work or installation with digital elements, a painting, drawing or collage with digital elements, a site specific work that incorporates digital elements, a virtual reality that incorporates non-digital elements, etc.

The final project should allow you to creatively develop ideas and techniques you have explored during the course, and expand on the application these ideas have in relation to other studio practices. The choices of non-digital medium and software are yours.

Submit a typed proposal that outlines:

- Your idea
- How you will go about your project
- What you will produce
- A plan of how you will use your time

Project development

Week 3: Monday, December 7:

Oral presentation of the physical project in class. Discuss technical methods used in creating the work and the content or meaning of your idea and its visual effectiveness. The final visual presentation of your project is very important. You must frame / mount / install / present / project (as applicable) your work in an appropriate and professional way. Photo document at least five stages of the work for your final Power Point presentation.

Week 3: Wednesday, December 9:

Present a Power Point slide show of the final project that includes:

- Your initial proposal
- Preliminary sketches / idea changes
- Photos of project development five stages minimum
- Quality photos of the final project. If the work is three dimensional, shoot from at least four different viewpoints.

Discuss the effectiveness of your results in the finished work.

Grading criteria:

Thoughtful and intelligent approach to proposal, creative approach to sketches and idea development, articulate in oral presentation, and professional quality photo documentation of at least five stages in the development of the work.
