

Criteria for Urgent Project

- 1. Governor or Chancellor's Office mandate
- 2. Presidential mandate
- 3. Audit response
- 4. Litigation or other court ordered response
- 5. Condition arises from an unforeseen occurrence or condition
 - Vendor goes out of business
 - o Natural disaster or abnormal weather event (fire, flood, storm, earthquake, etc.)
 - Security breach
- 6. Condition must require immediate corrective action which cannot await execution of proper project vetting
 - Critical equipment/hardware failure or support end of life
 - Building or infrastructure planning and/or installation
 - Timing is dependent on permit approvals, funding, contractor availability,
 weather, academic & payroll calendars, etc.
 - Software accessibility deficiencies identified after implementation that must be mitigated
 - Product end of life has been reached or is imminent
 - Contract expiration has been reached or is imminent, vendor will not extend
- 7. Condition causes significant business impact
 - More than 20% users cannot use a product/process/service
 - Criteria: system, type of users, time of year
 - Prospective and/or students, faculty, staff, alumni, auxiliaries, applicants
- 8. Condition may cause irreparable damage, severe incapacity, high risk for physical injury
