### **Undergraduate**

- TOEFL score of 510 paper, 64 iBT, or IELTS score 6.0
- Must also meet the following requirements:

### **First-Time Freshmen Requirements**

- High School/Secondary School Transcripts
- Minimum 3.0 out of 4.0 scale (average 80% marks)

### **Transfer Student Requirements**

Less than 60 credits/units:

High School Transcripts & All Postsecondary Transcripts Required Minimum 3.0 out of 4.0 scale (average 80% marks) from high school; and minimum 2.4 GPA from post-secondary institutions

More than 60 credits/units: All Postsecondary Transcripts Required Minimum 2.4 out of 4.0 GPA

### Graduate\*

- TOEFL score of 550 paper, 80 iBT, or IELTS score of 6.5 •
- A degree awarded by an accredited university equivalent to a four-year
- U.S. baccalaureate degree with the equivalent of a 2.50 GPA\* or higher
- Must also meet other standards for graduate study established by the academic department\*

### **Conditional Admission**

- Conditional Admission is available for students who are academically qualified, but have not met the English language requirement. Students are issued a conditional admission letter and must attend and successfully complete Intensive English classes at Sacramento State's English Language Institute (ELI) until they meet the language requirement.

- Graduate Conditional Admission available for select majors
