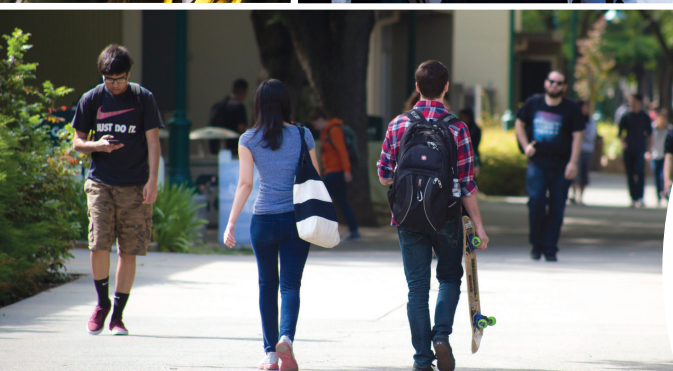

Conditional Admission

Conditional Admission is available for students who are academically qualified, but have not met the English language requirement. Students are issued a conditional admission letter and must attend and successfully complete intensive English classes at Sacramento State's English Language Institute (ELI) prior to beginning their academic coursework.

The English Language Institute offers five 8-week sessions throughout the year. The program is designed to help students easily transition to their degree programs at Sacramento State. For more information about ELI, visit cce.csus.edu/eli
