Pride Week celebrates the social and self-acceptance, achievements, legal rights, and history of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, non-binary, and queer individuals. The week-long celebration serves as a congratulatory recognition and remembrance of the cultural impact of LGBTQ leaders and the movement for global social justice. Pride Week 2021 will run from April 5th to the 9th, culminating with Queer Prom. Programming is open to Sac State students, staff, and faculty.
