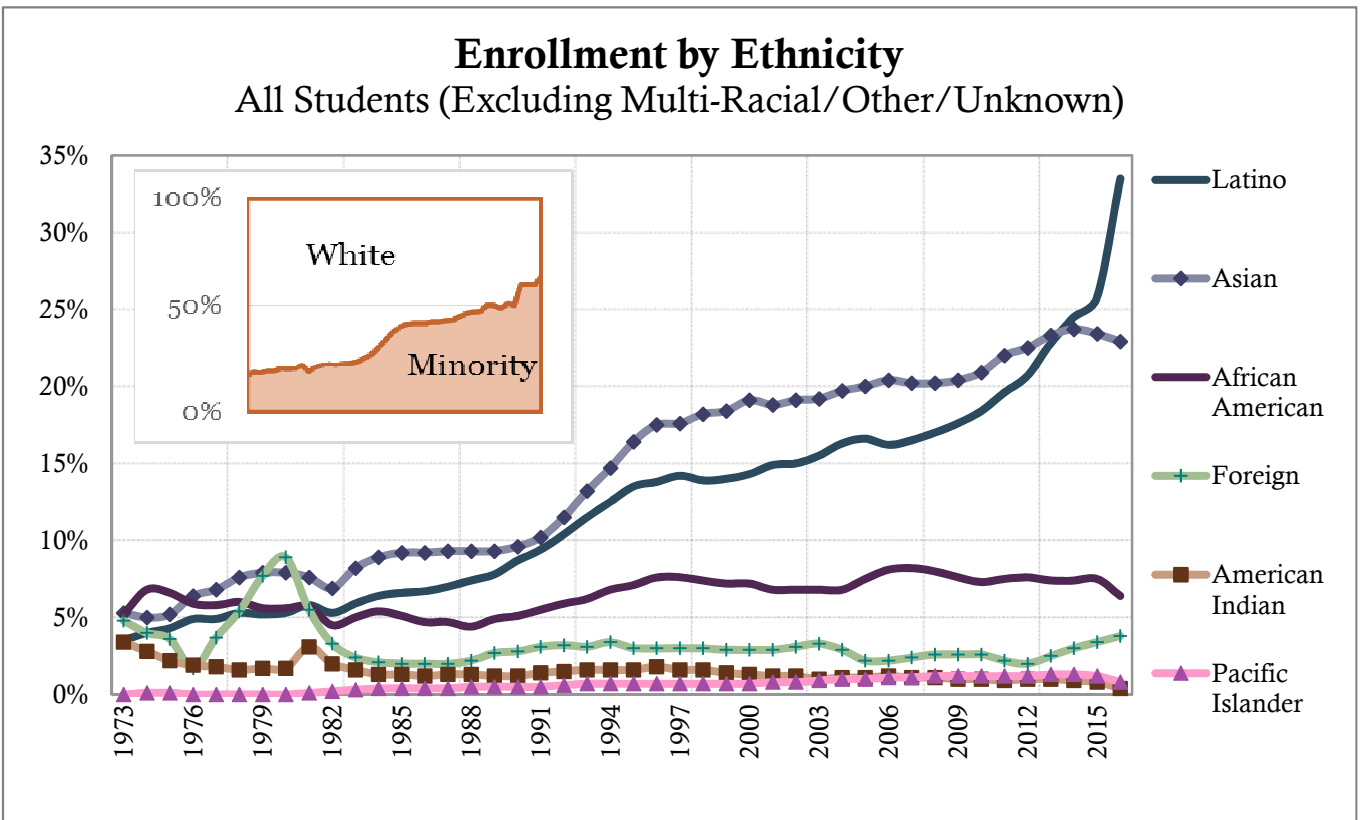
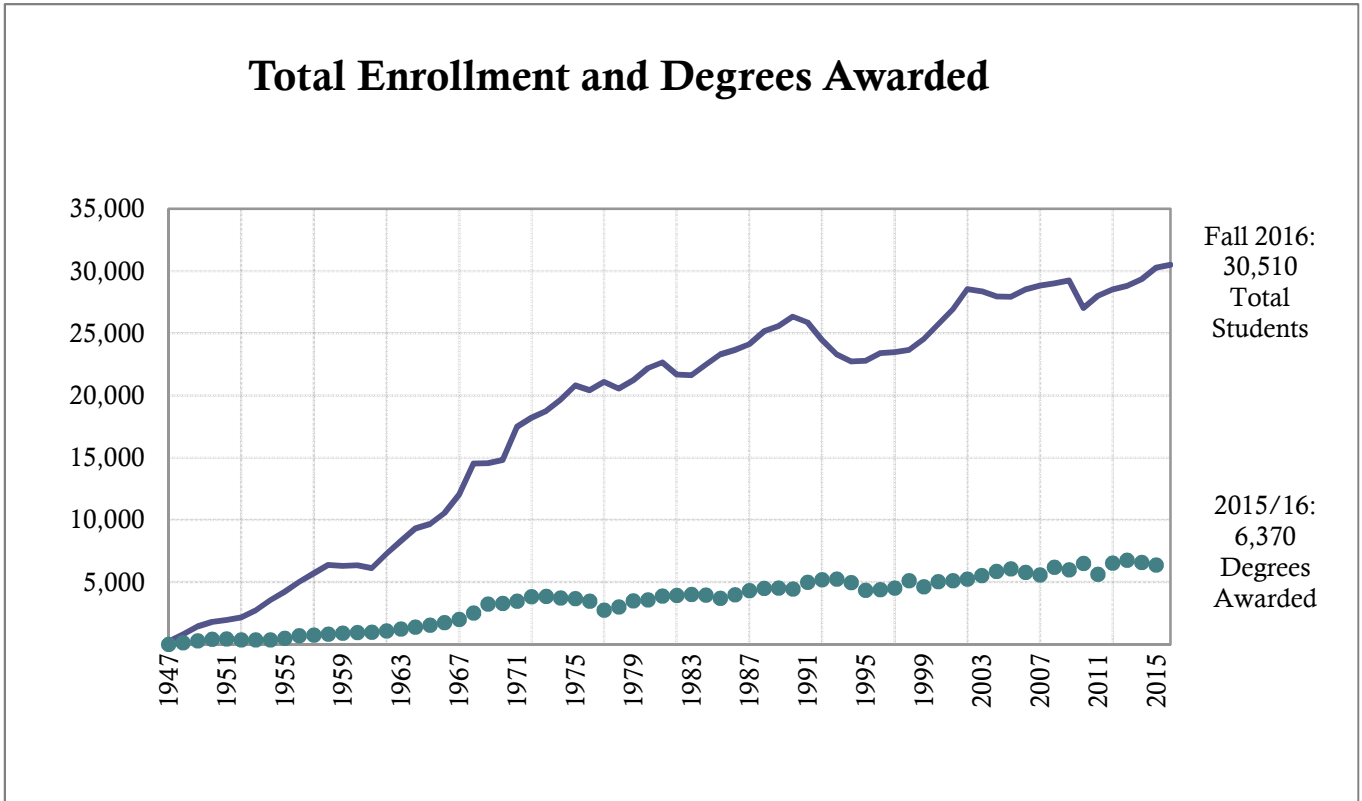

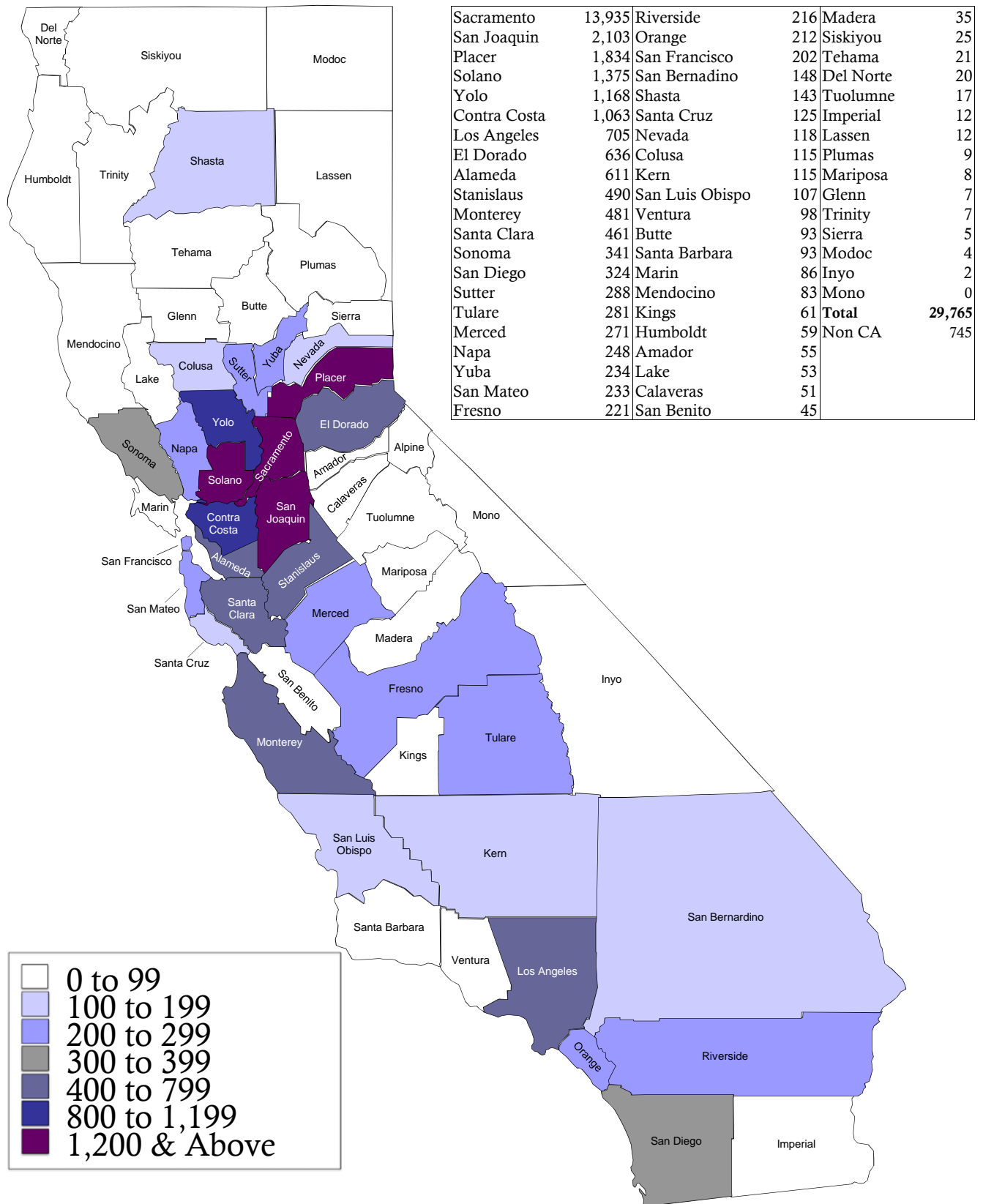

# Sacramento State Enrollment by CA County

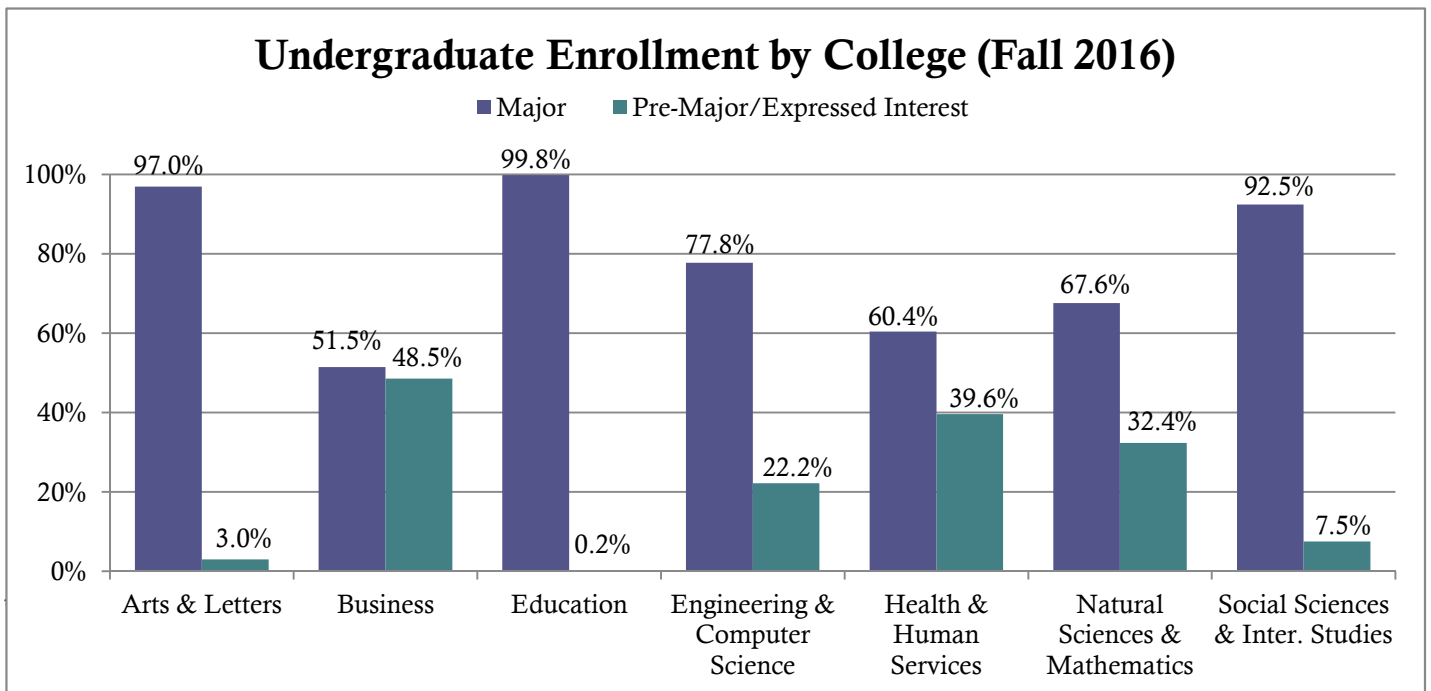

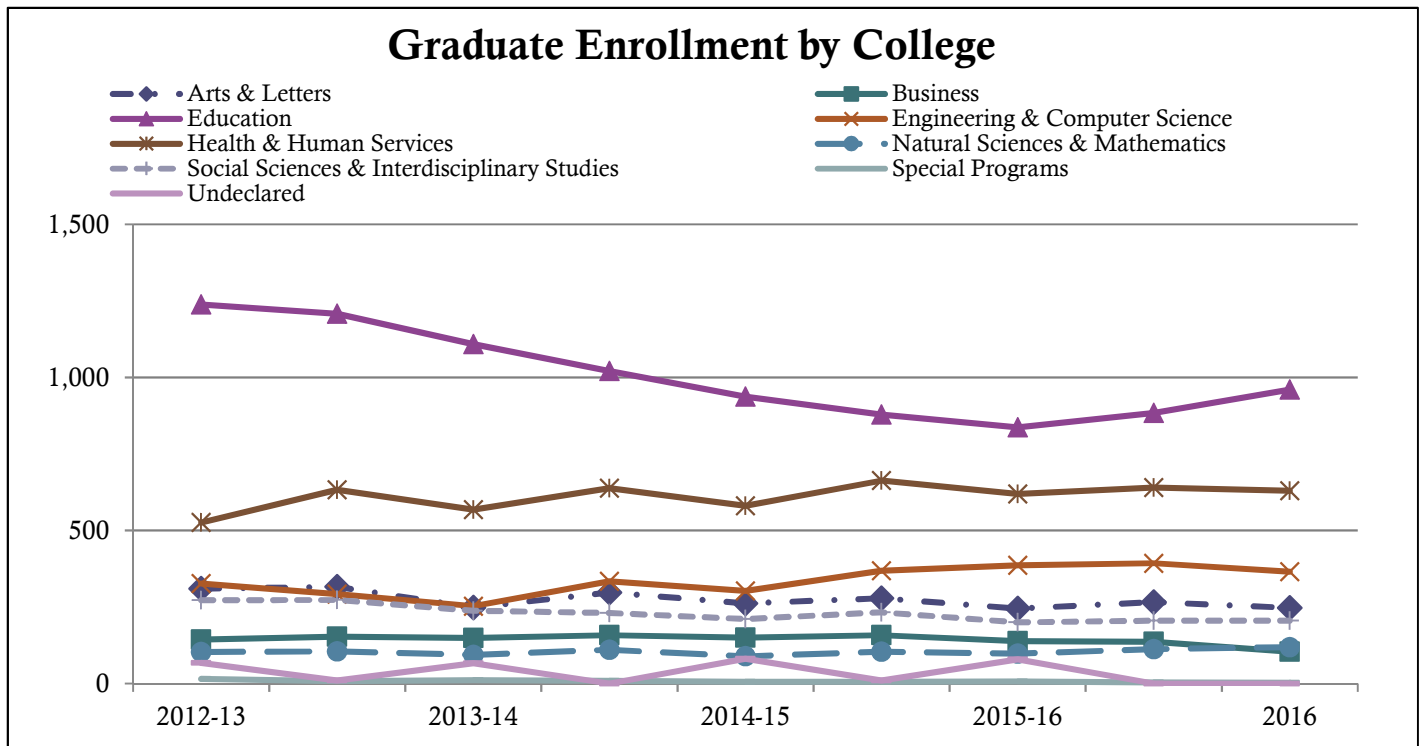

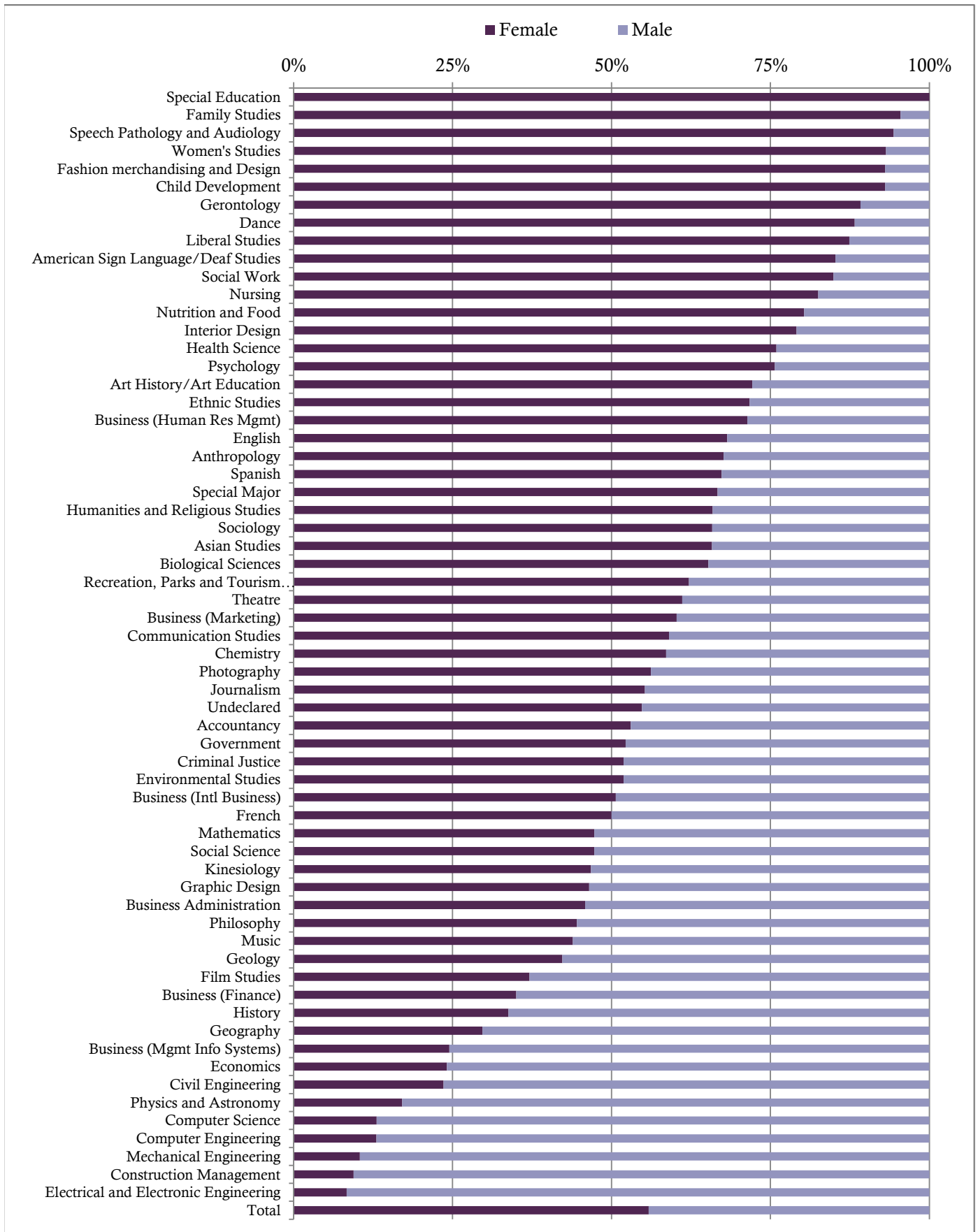
