

## MLK Center Red Ball (Frequently Asked Questions Page)

### 1. When will the MLK Center Red Ball occur?

The event will be held on Saturday, February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 from 6:00 pm – 8:30 pm at the Alumni Center.

### 2. Is parking provided?

Guests can access the permit on the event website the week of February 11th and will also be sent a permit in advance of the event date via email. Permits will also be available on site at the Alumni Center the day of the event.

### 3. What is the attire for the event?

In celebration of Black History Month guests are being asked to wear red or black or a combination of red and black formal attire. (Suggestions: Dresses and pant suits for the ladies and suits or shirts and ties for the men or a nice dress shirt and slacks).

### 4. Is the event free for students?

A total of 50 seats have been reserved for students, whose seats are being sponsored. The event is free of charge for students.
