APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Minutes of the meeting of 10/13/2017 was approved with one abstention (De-Laine)

INFORMATION ON COMMITTEE BUSINESS

- 1. OIR director Jim Dragna talked about the background of the National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE). NSSE is a national survey of first-year and senior undergraduate students to measure their engagement in high levels of learning and development.
- 2. The committee started to discuss about the CSUS NSSE 2017 report and summarized the following items regarding high impact practices (HIPs):
 - Male full-time students had lower response rate than female full-time students, which was generally true for most universities including CSUS.
 - Compared with the other California State Universities:
 - CSUS first-year students had higher participation rate in two or more HIPs.
 - CSUS first-year students had the same participation rate in one HIP.
 - Compared with the other Carnegie Class, and NSSE 2016 & 2017 Universities and Colleges:
 - CSUS senior students had smaller participation rate in two or more HIPs.
 - CSUS senior students had higher participation rate in one HIP.
 - A breakdown of the HIP participation rate of the CSUS transfer students will be useful in the future report.
