<u>Referral: Custodianship of Student Evaluations of Teaching:</u> The Deans were asked to consult with their units to respond to 5 questions regarding custodianship of paper Student Evaluations of Teaching (SETs) and respond by November 26. The Committee will review the information at the December 3 meeting.

The Committee reviewed the proposed language and made edits to the "Procedures to govern custodianship of student evaluations (on paper) of teaching forms (SETS)" for placement in Section 5.05 E 1.c (1) of the UARTP policy, immediately before the section titled, "Procedures to govern student evaluations submitted online". Once the information from the Colleges is received and reviewed, the Committee will finalize the amended language and then forward to the Executive Committee for placement on the Senate agenda.

Amendment of UARTP Policy Section 6.08: The Committee discussed whether Section 6.08 needs to address the recent amendments to the Role and Responsibility of the Department/Division Chair policy, specifically to consider the determination of who is eligible to vote. The determination of who is eligible to vote, both internal and external, is defined in CBA Article 2.13, which states all Unit 3 faculty members are eligible to vote in department chair elections.
