 - Allow students to feel belonged, create a multi-cultural environment
- Services

- Embedded counseling (diverse API counselor who understands API circumstances)
- Warm hand-off of students to other services
- Opportunities for mentoring from APIDA faculty, staff, administrators
- Programming (events, speakers, activities, workshops) with API background
- Create a peer-to-peer environment, where current students (or staff/faculty) can support new incoming students (academically, socially)
