

EOP-FCP First Year

About

The Full Circle Project (FCP) is an academic retention program that addresses and supports the diverse needs and interests of Sacramento State's Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) students as well as other high need students. The Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) serves California residents from low-income households who demonstrate the motivation and potential to earn a baccalaureate degree. Incoming AAPI first-year students often apply to both programs to receive the most opportunities and support as they transition from high school to Sacramento State. Academic advising is an integral program service that many students can benefit from in their educational, professional, personal, and leadership developments. Any accepted incoming FCP first-year students that are also accepted to EOP will follow the EOP first-year advising requirement.

Advising Description

Academic advising takes place in a one-on-one or group setting that provides an intentional process of assisting FCP first-year students with their educational plans and requirements based on their major, interests, and needs. Counselors, Graduate Advisors, Peer Mentors, and Instructional Student Assistants will be available to give students essential information and resources to help clarify any questions or concerns, develop educational goals and plans to meet general education and graduation requirements, explore majors and interests, and cultivate a sense of belonging on campus.

EOP-FCP First-Year Advising Requirement

EOP-FCP First-Year Advising Requirement: You must meet with your Instructional Student Assistant (ISA who teaches your ALS 70A).

Fall 2020: You must meet with your ISA at least once in the fall semester to complete your first-year academic advising requirement for fall 2020.

Spring 2021: You must meet with an FCP Graduate Advisor at least once in the spring semester to complete your first-year academic advising requirement for spring 2021.

Please note: You are highly encouraged to meet with your Peer Mentor, ISA, Graduate Advisor, and/or Counselor more than once per semester to ensure that you are on a good standing towards your degree. Aside from your semesterly requirement, feel free to schedule an appointment with any EOP and FCP staff to receive advising and or office time to discuss about any of your challenges, needs, or experiences at Sacramento State.
