



## Fall 2020 – Transfer Student Eligibility

### 5 Easy Steps to Apply & Complete the EOP Application Process;

**STEP 1:** Transfer student must complete 60 or more college transferable units and earn a C- or better in the following areas (**A1-** Communications, **A2-** Writing Communications, **A3-** Critical Thinking & **B4-** Mathematics or Quantitative Reasoning).

**STEP 2:** Apply for Admissions to **Sacramento State** and the **EOP Program** between **October 1st through November 30, 2019**. [Apply Online](http://www.calstate.edu/apply) [www.calstate.edu/apply](http://www.calstate.edu/apply)

**STEP 3:** Answer the EOP Bibliography essay questions listed below as part of the online EOP application.

**STEP 4:** Submit a FAFSA or Dream Act Application between **October 1st- March 2nd** (EOP Applicant must have an **Expected Family Contribution** (EFC) of **\$1,500** or less.

**STEP 5:** Submit two electronic EOP Letters of Recommendation by **1/31/2020**

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## Fall 2020 – First-Time Freshmen Student Eligibility

### 5 Easy Steps to Apply & Complete the EOP Application Process;

**STEP 1:** High School Graduating Seniors must;

- Earn a C or higher in all “**A-G Subjects**”
- Complete either the **SAT** or **ACT** testing
- Must be a **California Resident** or **AB-540 eligible**

**STEP 3:** Answer the EOP Bibliography essay questions listed below as part of the online EOP application.

**STEP 4:** Submit a FAFSA or Dream Act Application between **October 1, 2019- March 2, 2020** (EOP Applicant must have an **Expected Family Contribution** (EFC) of **\$1,500** or less.

**STEP 5:** Submit two electronic EOP Letters of Recommendation by **1/31/2020**

- 3) Briefly discuss your academic background. Did you utilize any additional support at your high school, such as tutoring? Do your grades in high school and/or college reflect your academic ability or potential?
- 4) List any volunteer, extracurricular activities, or work experience in which you are or have been involved in the past two years.
- 5) Is there any additional information you would like EOP to consider in determining your admission to the program?
