#### **Project Rebound**

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## Supporting the formerly incarcerated on their journey through successful reintegration in a college setting.

In 1967 Professor John Irwin created Project Rebound as a way to matriculate people into San Francisco State University (SFSU) directly from the criminal Justice system. The focus of Project Rebound quickly became "Education as an Alternative to incarceration" and "Turning Former Prisoners to Scholars." Since the program's inception hundreds of formerly incarcerated people have obtained four year degrees and beyond. In 2016, we are moving beyond the confines of SFSU onto seven other CSU campuses. With the help of a new team of professionals we will support students at CSU Fullerton, Fresno, San Diego, San Bernardino, Sacramento, Pomona, and Bakersfield.

#### **Campus and Community Support**

The program also acts as a liaison between networks throughout the campus at-large as well as throughout the communities in and around the CSU locations. We utilize a multitude of educational, tutorial, and vocational resources. We focus on the whole student and provide referrals to counseling and networking with human service provider programs that can best serve our student's needs.

#### **Admission Strategies**

- 1. Fill-out our questionnaire, answering all questions and return it to our office.
- 2. If you qualify we will send you instructions on how to apply to the university.
- 3. If you are not ready to begin at Sacramento State, we will assist with obtaining any additional requirements at local community colleges to transfer to Sacramento State.
- 4. People with "drug case" may qualify for Financial Aid (Financial Aid consists of free grants and/or loans given to students attending school.) 1-3 years after a conviction. DO NOT be discouraged. There are still ways to get Financial Aid.
