Q: I am a continuing student, how can I turn in my Veteran Enrollment Certificate after I have registered for Summer and/or Fall 2020?

California Veteran Tuition Fee Waiver Program

- The Cal Vet Tuition **Waiver CANNOT be used for Summer Session and Winter Intersession** at Sac State.
- The Cal Vet Tuition Fee Waiver for Veteran dependents waives **mandatory system-wide tuition** at any public institution of higher education.
- At Sac State, it waives tuition, it does NOT waive campus-based mandatory fees.
- It does NOT cover books, parking, or room and board.
- The Veterans Success Center **does NOT approve/deny Cal Vet Tuition Fee Waiver**, the application needs to be submitted to the County Veteran Service Office.
- Students should renew/re-apply every **calendar** year for the upcoming **academic year**.

Summer 2020

Q: When can I register for Summer 2020 courses?

Students that receive priority registration can register for courses April 13th. Open registration begins April 20th.

Q: How many Summer Sessions are there?

There are 3 summer sessions:

First 6-week Session May 26 – July 2

Second 6-week Session July 6 – August 14

Full 12-week Session May 26 – August 14

Q: What is considered full-time for each Summer Session?

Full time for each summer session is 4 units.

Q: How can I maintain full-time status through the whole summer?

These are the scenarios in which a student can maintain full-time status throughout the summer:

Scenario 1

Take a 4 unit course in First 6-week Session Take a 4 unit course in the Second 6-week Session

**This is the easiest way to achieve full-time status across the whole summer.*

Scenario 2

Take a 3 unit course in the First 6-week Session Take a 3 unit course in the Second 6-week Session Take a 3 unit course in the Full 12-week Session

**This is how the majority of students maintain full-time status across the whole summer.*

Scenario 3

Take a 3 unit course in the First 6-week Session Take a 3 unit course in the Second 6-week Session Take a 1 unit course in the Full 12-week Session

**This can be unlikely as there may not be a 1 unit course offered across the full 12-week session.*
